

Chimacum Schools Board of Directors Goals 2018-2019

These goals align to Chimacum School District Policy 1005

RESPONSIBLE GOVERNANCE:

Recognizing strong and visionary leadership is vital to our District, the Board will demonstrate the highest level of professional integrity and accountability as we expend those financial resources which our community has entrusted to us.

CREATING CONDITIONS FOR STUDENT & STAFF SUCCESS:

Accepting it is our responsibility to provide safe and educationally adequate facilities, the Board will direct the Superintendent to complete a fully-vetted, long-term facilities plan by 12/31/18.

Convinced an engaged student is a successful student, we will expect documented data (from the students' permanent file) assuring no less 75% of middle and high school students participated in at least one co-curricular activity in the 2018-19 school year.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENT LEARNING:

Understanding although it is only a partial metric for evaluating the whole student, the Board expects test scores for Chimacum students to exceed the state average at all grades and in all subjects.

Believing a student must be in class to learn, we expect unexcused student absences to, at a minimum, meet the statewide average. At the same time, chronic absenteeism will be reduced to equal the statewide average.

ACCOUNTABILITY FOR STUDENT LEARNING:

Concluding it our responsibility to ensure student success, we expect an increase in the District's five-year graduation rate to 94% for the 18-19 school year.

ENGAGEMENT OF COMMUNITY IN EDUCATION:

With the purpose to expand understanding and appreciation for our community's schools, the Board will initiate permanent measures to connect our schools to both our community's heritage and its future no later than 6/30/19.
