Return to In-Person Learning

We will be returning to in-person learning on Thursday, January 21st. Our model will be altered to meet the academic needs of all students. A ½ day, five days a week, cohort model will allow our staff to focus on reading, writing, and math in smaller instructional groups. The smaller cohort groups will allow for the six feet of spacing that is required for every student in the classroom.

Breakfast and lunch will be handed out daily when the students leave school. The earlier model allowed students to eat breakfast at school, but we will be able to maximize the learning for each student by handing the meals out at the end of the school day.

Start and End Times

Cohort A- 9:00 to 11:30

Cohort B- 1:10 to 3:40

Students are in the same cohort that they were in during our original hybrid model, unless contacted by a staff member.

Current 100% Remote Students

Our students and families that are currently with their 100% remote only teacher can stay with their current configuration. If you are interested in switching to our in-person learning model, please contact your teacher directly.

School COVID Guidelines

The following is a summary of the protocol we still must follow if a student or staff member exhibits symptoms of COVID-19:

1. If 2 or fewer of the less specific symptoms resolve in 24 hours (fatigue, body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea) THEN students may return to school when fever-free and improving symptoms after 24 hours.
2. If any of the more specific symptoms are exhibited (fever of 100.4 or greater or chills, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, or new loss of taste or smell) THEN students or staff need to get a COVID-19 test.
3. If the COVID-19 test is negative, then students/staff may return to school when fever-free for 24 hours and improved symptoms.
4. If no COVID-19 test is obtained, then students/staff may return to school after 10 days AND symptom-free for 24 hours.
5. If a COVID-19 test is positive, then the student/staff member will be excluded from school and Jefferson County Public Health will advise on a return date.
