Subject: School Wide Masking Order, Chimacum Jr/Sr High

Based on our assessment of the amount of COVID-19 transmission at Chimacum Jr/Sr High, we are issuing a school-wide masking order. All staff and students are required to wear a well-fitting mask over mouth and nose while indoors at school for the next seven days. The purpose of this order is to mitigate transmission of COVID-19 and keep the school open.

**Duration of Protocol**

**The precautions outlined here must be implemented immediately and continued at least through Friday, May 20, 2022, then re-evaluated in consultation with Public Health.**

**COVID-19 Testing**

Testing is **strongly encouraged** of all staff and students in attendance, except those with test-confirmed COVID-19 infection within the last 90 days. JCPH will provide sufficient testing supplies for staff and students to take home. They should be instructed to test today or at some time before returning to school on Monday, and again if/when symptoms appear.

**Test Results**

Students or staff who test positive must report their results and isolate at home for a minimum of 5 days after their symptoms started, or positive test if asymptomatic.
